a) Monthly response and service report: Fire Chief Jobusch presented the information from the May and June 20209 response reports. Chief Jobusch discussed that the last two months were fairly typical. There was a large house fire in the south Gilbert that had issue with water access. They were able to control it and there were no injuries.
